

SUMMER 2018: POLICY INTERNSHIPS IN WASHINGTON, DC

[The National Academy of Social Insurance](#) invites outstanding graduate and upper division undergraduate students to apply for an internship in public policy in Washington, DC this summer. Students pursuing law, political science, public policy, health policy, gerontology, social work, economics, communications, actuarial science, or related degrees are encouraged to apply. Interns receive a \$4,500 honorarium and academic credit may be arranged. The program consists of a 12-week full-time placement that usually spans May to August, depending on the student's schedule.

Students are placed with an organization or government agency that matches their interests and educational background. They will work under the supervision of Academy members who are experts in the field of social insurance. Past placements include AARP, Center for Global Policy Solutions, Community Catalyst, Congressional Committees, Medicaid and CHIP Payment and Access Commission, Social Security Advisory Board, and more!

The Academy's internship programs --[The Washington Internship on Social Insurance](#), [The Somers Aging and Long-Term Care Research Internship](#), [The Rashi Fein Internship in Health Policy](#), and [The Eileen Sweeney Graduate Internship in Disability Policy](#) – provide talented students with a substantive learning experience that can help them become contributors and future leaders in this field. A unique feature of the Academy internship is attendance at weekly seminars, Congressional hearings on Capitol Hill, policy forums, and the Academy gala held in June.



Academy and Internship Details

The Academy is a nonprofit, nonpartisan organization with 1,000+ members. The Academy's programmatic scope covers U.S. social insurance programs – primarily Social Security, Workers' Compensation, unemployment insurance, Medicare, other health coverage programs, disability policy, and long-term services and supports.

Time commitment: Full-time for 12 weeks beginning in May/June to Aug/Sept 2018 (dates are flexible).

Application deadline: March 1, 2018. Application materials must be received by this date.

Location: Washington, D.C., various placements.

Honorarium: \$4,500 stipend to offset living expenses.
