

SUMMER 2019: APPLY FOR A POLICY INTERNSHIP IN WASHINGTON, DC



[The National Academy of Social Insurance](#) invites outstanding graduate and upper division undergraduate students to apply for an internship in public policy in Washington, DC this summer. Students pursuing law, political science, public policy, health policy, gerontology, social work, economics, communications, actuarial science, or related degrees are encouraged to apply. Interns receive a \$4,500 honorarium to offset living expenses in DC, and academic credit may be arranged. The program consists of a 12-week full-time placement that usually spans May to August, depending on the student's schedule.

The Academy is a nonprofit, nonpartisan organization with 1,000+ Members across the country. The Academy's programmatic scope covers U.S. social insurance and related issues – primarily Social Security, Medicare, Medicaid, and other health programs, disability policy, long-term services and supports, caregiving, workers' compensation, unemployment insurance, and inequality.

Each student who is accepted into the program is placed with an organization that matches her/his interests and educational background. S/he works under the supervision of an Academy Member who is a top expert in the field of social insurance. Past placements include: AFL-CIO, Community Catalyst, Congressional Research Service, Medicaid and CHIP Payment and Access Commission (MACPAC), Social Security Advisory Board, and congressional committees. The program includes weekly seminars and networking opportunities, including attending the Academy's annual gala in June.
