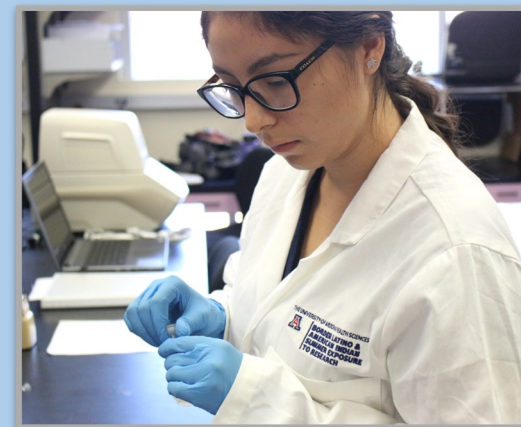




PROGRAM DATES: JUNE 3—AUGUST 6, 2019
