2. 61 cases of COVID on campus to date

5. New Oxivir spray has one minute dwell time
6. Cleaning frequency will be 5 days per week for classrooms. Please let Chris's team know what areas will not reopen on August 24th, so that cleaning efforts can be focused on areas that are open.
7. Flowchart for ordering supplies to be released next week
8. Fit tests for N95 masks also require a medical evaluation and there is a cost associated with that
9. Due to the hand sanitizer station shortage: one gallon containers will be issued and the carpenter shop will create holders for all entrances and all classrooms.
10. Touch free paper towel dispensers are now installed in Drachman Hall restrooms
11. Signage installed in all campus elevators
12. Cloth mask delivery delayed until August 20th
13. Elevator ventilation: still no good guidance on this, recommend using stairs for anyone who is able to
14. Are we moving any furniture out of the bridge or waiting/reception areas? If we need space to store items, let project manager know
15. Project managers will be assigned to colleges for the next year
16. Classroom capacity list is still being updated, Drachman Hall still not on list
17. For a rough idea of capacity for classrooms: For departmentally controlled spaces use the Space tab on Planning Design & Constructions website. Each room has a capacity listed. Halve the capacity until guidelines are released. <https://pdc.arizona.edu/space/>
18. Every student will be required to take the antigen test before returning to school (program to start next Friday)
19. Antibody testing to start 07/20/2020 (this is a research project, so people that want a test, must sign up) (this will occur at North Rec)
20. Toilet plume: does it transmit virus, FM has been continuing to follow CDC guidance which does not indicate that the virus is spread via toilet plume
21. FM is reviewing all restrooms on campus for air exchange quality and will be taking actions to increase/improve air exchange in restrooms
22. 500 research labs have come back online
23. When will buildings be taken off restrictive access?
24. Spacing: The following guidelines must be adopted for shared research spaces: no more than one (1) individual per 144 square foot per room/workspace. Other documented and approved approaches may be allowed.
25. Paper towels will be provided by FM with Oxivir spray until disinfecting wipes can be procured
26. Are gloves needed for applying Oxivir: no, but FM will provide gloves for disinfecting surfaces (Rachel to order additional gloves). Gloves will be supplied in classes for applying disinfectant if individuals want to use (especially for individuals with sensitive skin).
27. Chris Kopach to follow up on potential bottleneck that will occur during mask distribution
28. Postal services will not be delivering across campus until colleges let them know they have reopened and they can't accommodate special days/times, the college must be open M-F 8a-5p, otherwise you may continue to pick up mail at central receiving
29. Please only order what is needed to re-open for PPE, so that campus supply isn't depleted
30. FM to put a link on the website regarding HVAC air exchange quality so that people can easily read about this
