From UAHS Pre-Award:

The UAHS Preaward team must be notified of all planned training grants (T32s, R25s) at least 3 months in advance. We cannot accommodate last minute training grants (and experience has shown these are also never funded), and due to the manual nature of all of the tables, need this lead time to plan and prepare.

- a. We will actively discourage the same PI leading more than one training grant at a time, and will escalate to the ADR as needed.
- b. If there are two faculty members interested in applying for the same Institute, preference will be given to revised applications and to renewals-will loop in the ADRs to discuss/adjudicate.
