Are you an undergraduate or graduate student, interested in health careers and health disparities in the U.S. – Mexico border community?

Focusing Research on the Border Area (FRONTERA) Summer Internship provides undergraduate and graduate students with opportunities to prepare for graduate school, hands-on research experience, and an increased understanding of public health disparities in the U.S.-Mexico Border Region.

Who should apply?

- Undergraduates who will be juniors and seniors in Fall 2018, graduate students, and post-bacc students interested in health careers are all welcome to apply.
- At a minimum, applicants should have completed one year in biology and general chemistry, and have an overall GPA of 3.0.
- Students from rural and US-Mexico border origins, first-generation college, socio-economically disadvantaged, members of federally-recognized Native American tribes, and from racial and ethnic groups traditionally underrepresented in medicine (Hispanic, Native American and African American) are especially encouraged to apply.
- Applicants are required to be current University of Arizona students or recent graduates (May of 2019).
