The UA Office of Fellowships and Community Engagement (OFCE)

Application Support Programs:

Summer Application Support Program: The OFCE offers a Summer Application Support Program for anyone applying to a fellowship to support graduate or postdoctoral work. The program includes the following:

- Deadlines – Three submission deadlines for applicants to submit drafts of their essays and receive feedback from Graduate Editors.
- Examples – Examples of previously successful applications for current applicants.
- Writing session – Opportunities to get together and write.

Fall NSF GRFP Support Program: Similar to the Summer Program, the Fall program specifically supports applicants to the NSF GRFP through deadlines, feedback, examples, mentoring and writing sessions.
