- [TRIF National Security Systems Cyber Exploitation](#) - Due October 30, 2023
 - Up to \$35,000
 - Must include at least 1 undergraduate researcher
- [Dean's Annual Fund](#) - next due date is November 1, 2023
 - \$100 to \$3500 awards
 - For community programs and/or research activities mainly in *Health Promotion and Disease Prevention*
- [Dean's Strategic Initiatives and Innovation Fund](#) - application open now, due October 23, 2023
 - \$5,000 - \$50,000 awards over 18 months
- [2024 One Health Postdoctoral Fellowship](#) - proposal due October 18, 2023
 - For transdisciplinary research teams to hire a postdoctoral fellow for One Health Projects

PREVIOUS:

- [CO APCD Scholarship Fund, FY24](#) - Scholarships are awarded on a first-come, first-served basis, which begins July 1st. It is recommended to submit applications as early as possible.
 - Eligibility: researchers affiliated with public, state-supported institutions of higher education
- [Wellcome Trust: Mental Health Award](#) - Due November 14, 2023
 - Understanding how anxiety- and trauma-related problems develop, persist and resolve
 - Up to £4,000,000 over up to 5 years
- [Burroughs Wellcome Fund: Next Gen Pregnancy Initiative](#) - Due December 5, 2023
 - \$500,000 over a 4 year period (\$125,000 per year)
 - areas of interest include: relationship between duration of pregnancy, fetal growth, and adverse pregnancy outcomes, as well as climate change and environmental impact on pregnancy
- [Burroughs Wellcome Fund: Postdoctoral Diversity Enrichment Program](#) - Due January 18, 2024
 - Application opens in October
 - \$60,000 over 3 years
 - supports the career development activities for underrepresented minority postdoctoral fellows

 - Eligibility: Graduate students, post-doctoral fellows, healthcare professionals
 - Up to \$6,000 fellowship
