I. Organizational Purpose and Background: The Pima County Health Department (PCHD) is seeking an intern to support the work of the Epidemiology Division and its programs. We are seeking a motivated and detail-oriented intern to assist with epidemiological projects. As an intern, you will have the opportunity to work closely with our team in investigating possible disease sources, collecting and analyzing data, and providing information to the public. This internship is designed to provide valuable experience in the field of epidemiology and public health.

II. Project Focus Areas and Activities

- Assist in investigating disease sources, including conducting interviews with patients and contacts
- Collect and analyze data to identify disease patterns and trends
- Assist in providing information and education services to the public regarding disease prevention and control measures
- Collaborate with team members to promote uniform investigative methods and reporting procedures with physicians, laboratories, and community health facilities
- Prepare and submit manual and computer-based reports as directed by supervisory staff
- Plan, design, and coordinate special projects investigating epidemiological problems
- Any additional tasks as assigned
