Project Description:

We are looking for **one student intern from Arizona State University, one from University of Arizona, and one from Northern Arizona University** to act as representatives and liaisons from PPAZ to BIPOC organizations and students on their campuses.

General Responsibilities

- Create communication and relationships with BIPOC campus organizations.
- Work with the PPAZ Marketing & Communications team to promote PPAZ through campus communication opportunities.
- Work with the PPAZ Educators to offer sexual and reproductive health information to students.
- Attend on-campus activities to encourage BIPOC students to attend PPAZ educational offerings.
- Encourage students to apply for PPAZ's doula program.

Qualifications:

We are looking for people who:

- Are committed to the mission of Planned Parenthood.
- Are students enrolled at Arizona State University, University of Arizona, or Northern Arizona University.
- Have excellent communication and organizational skills.
- Have the ability to invest 10 hours per week in internship activities, for 20 weeks for a total of 200 hours.

We are looking for young leaders from historically underrepresented identities to lead an abortion access event that reflects the needs of their communities while bearing in mind the current reality of statewide restrictions and other barriers in the state they live in. Folks who are people of color, Black, Indigenous, are immigrants, and anyone who has faced systemic oppression are encouraged to apply.
