 - Eligibility: U.S. Citizen, Scientist, Tenured or similarly ranked faculty at a U.S. academic institution
- [NIH Fogarty Global Health Equity Scholars \(GHES\) Fellowship Program](#): Applications due October 1, 2024
 - Applications open for 2025-2026 Fellowship program

- Eligible applicants are U.S. postdoctoral trainees, U.S. students enrolled in a doctorate program or professional degree program, and LMIC postdoctoral trainees who are residents of the 17 collaborating LMICs.

 - For students from a racial or ethnic group that is underrepresented in the sciences, must be a member of American College of Sports Medicine
 - Masters students: \$4000
 - PhD students: \$6,000
- [Grapes from California Health Research Grant Program](#)- LOI Due October 8, 2024
 - Seeking research to help discover how and why grapes are beneficial to health, such as heart, joint, brain, eye health, and certain cancers.
 - \$50,000 grants
- [NIH, Department of Health and Human Services: NLM Grants for Scholarly Works in Biomedicine and Health \(G13 Clinical Trial Not Allowed\)](#)- LOI Due January 26, 2025
 - Application due February 26, 2025
