AS THE SUMMER 2018 SAFER INTERN, YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ROUTINE SURVEILLANCE INTERVIEWS FOR ENTERIC ILLNESS AND A DATA ANALYSIS PROJECT. THESE RESPONSIBILITIES FULFILL YOUR MPH OR PUBLIC HEALTH INTERNSHIP REQUIREMENT.

The Student Aide for Field Epidemiology Response (SAFER) team is recruiting for the summer 2018 SAFER Intern position. This position includes a stipend. You will work closely with a team of 2-3 peers, under the supervision of Dr. Kristen Pogreba-Brown and Erika Barrett.

Prior enrollment in the SAFER class is not required

The ideal candidate will:

- Have an interest in foodborne or enteric diseases
- Have completed required core courses (Graduate) for internship
- Have an interest in epidemiology, data analysis, and be a Junior or Senior (Undergraduate)
- Be able to work independently and receive feedback

The position will start in May, 2018 and continue through August, 2018 and will be about 10-15 hours a week depending on availability. The data analysis project can be tailored to fit your interests, but will utilize the enteric disease surveillance data collected through SAFER. The project must benefit the SAFER team and the Maricopa County Department of Public Health. This project fulfills your MPH internship requirements and includes a stipend.
