Project Description:

Bike Club is a unique program offered specifically at the Roy Drachman Clubhouse. This program is designed to teach and enable youth to safely ride a bicycle on and off the street. In addition, Bike Club teaches proper bike maintenance, repair, and proper safety. At the end of the program, youth will be able to safely and confidently navigate their bike on the road. The program includes 8 to 10 (30-45 minute) sessions (one day a week). The student may be asked to complete a brief safety course in order to effectively deliver the program.
